We accept all students that are nominated by the partner institution. Official letters of acceptance will be sent out to the students within: SI LJUBL01: 4 weeks and B LEUVEN01: 12 weeks after the deadline for application.

- A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the
 assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI. [It should normally not exceed five weeks
 according to the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education guidelines]
- 4. Termination of the agreement

This agreement will be in effect for the full duration of the ERASMUS+ Programme. In case of premature termination, a notice of at least one academic year will be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.
