The grading scale has five grades, which means that, including the intermediate grades, 10 pass grades (from 1.0 to 4.0) and one fallure grade (5.0) can be awarded. Intermediate grades can be awarded in order to provide a finer differentiation of the grading of the performance. This is done by raising or lowering the individual grades by 0.3. However, the grades 0.7, 4.3, 4.7 and 5.3 cannot be awarded.
