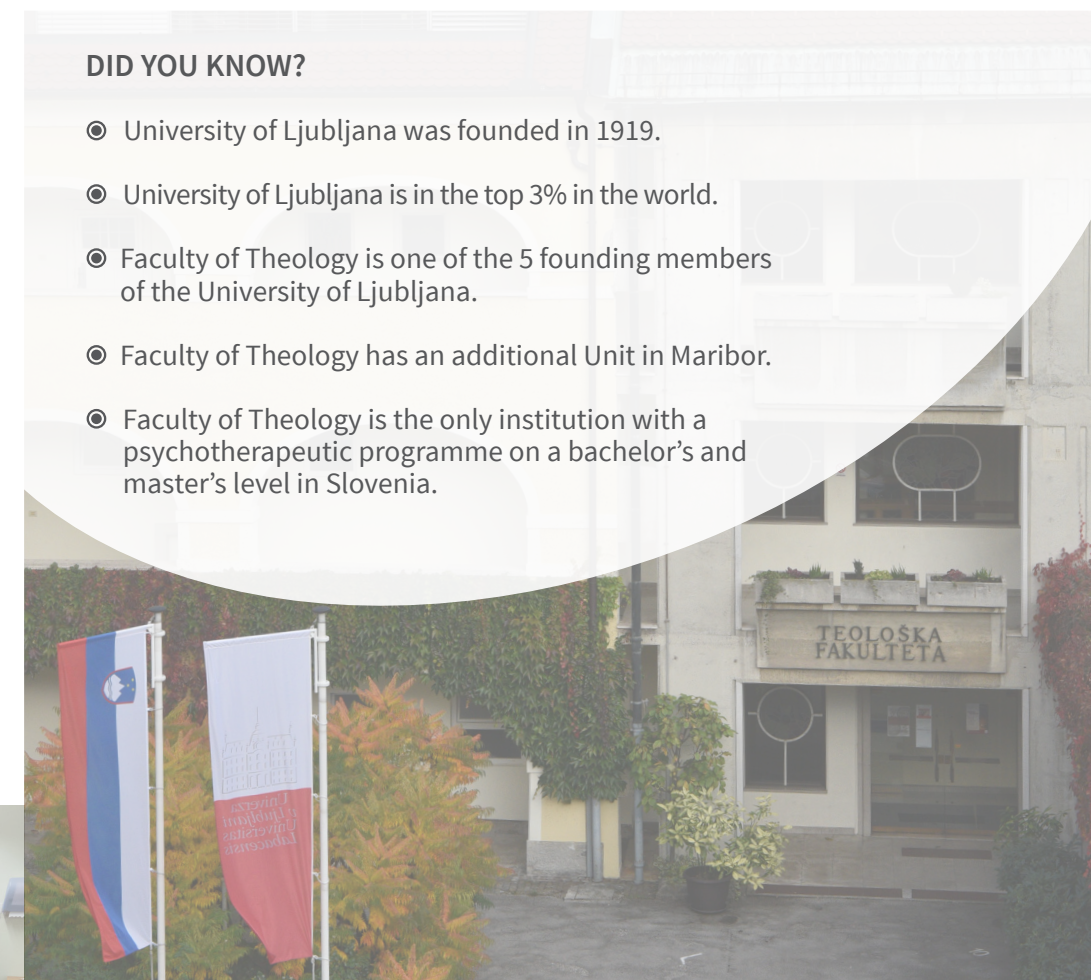
APPLICATION PERIOD

BACHELOR'S DEGREE PROGRAMME



HUMAN AND INTERPERSONAL RELATIONSHIPS (NEW)

MARRIAGE AND FAMILY THERAPY AND COUNSELLING

3 years, 180 ECTS

This brand-new programme provides students with the basic knowledge in the field of psychotherapy, marital and family therapy and counselling. Students gain knowledge in the field of developmental psychology, psychopathology, psychiatry, diagnostics or assessment, neuropsychology, basics of psychotherapy, medicine, and other aspects of psychotherapeutic work.

DEPARTMENT OF THEOLOGICAL AND RELIGIOUS STUDIES

3 years, 180 ECTS

The programme is based on a wide range of knowledge and methods from the humanities, social sciences, culture, theology, and religion. Students gain basic knowledge in the fields of Christianity, other religious beliefs, cultural history, and ethics.

MASTER'S DEGREE PROGRAMME

THEOLOGY

(Single Cycle Master Programme)

5 years, 300 ECTS

The Theology study programme is the basic programme of the Faculty of Theology and provides students with a vast knowledge in history, anthropology, philosophy, cultural studies, archaeology, biblical sciences, psychology, sociology, educational and rhetorical sciences. Theology has a long tradition, and its primary subject of study is the human person.

RELIGIOUS STUDIES AND ETHICS

2 years, 120 ECTS

The study of Religiology and Ethics gives the greatest emphasis to the humanities or philosophical, ethical, spiritual, theological, and religious concepts of life and interpersonal relationships. Students get acquainted with the methodology in the field of religious research and with the relationship between religions, ethics, and media.

EDUCATION IN THEOLOGY - IN CONNECTION WITH THE FACULTY OF ARTS (Combined Teacher Education Programme)

2 years, 120 ECTS

In this second cycle study programme, students upgrade their previous education with pedagogical and didactic skills. At the level of master's study, students gain specialized knowledge and skills that complement their basic knowledge in the field of belief and the system of religions, to be used in educational practice.

MARITAL AND FAMILY STUDIES

2 years, 120 ECTS

The programme prepares graduates for professional careers related to work with families, couples, young people, pre-school and school children and the elderly in the home, church, and community environments. Students gain knowledge in family and marital relations, problems and deviation, the development of individuals, marriage and family and the assessment of individuals in the marriage and family contexts.

DOCTORAL DEGREE PROGRAMME

THEOLOGY

The doctoral study programme Theology prepares students for scientific research and counselling work in the fields of humanities and social sciences (spirituality, ethics, intercultural and interreligious relations, therapeutic counselling).

MARITAL AND FAMILY THERAPY

Doctoral students prepare for employment in agencies and organizations serving children, adolescents, families, and adults, e.g., in the field of management, development, coordination of various development programmes, family and marital counselling, family inclusion and counselling in schools and educational institutions, parenting and family education programmes, parenting conferences, research on family and marital phenomena.

HUMANITIES AND SOCIAL SCIENCES - RELIGIOLOGY

The doctoral programme offers a more extensive and in-depth approach to the subject of Cultural Studies, Theology, Religious Studies and Ethics, Sociology of Culture, Philosophy of Culture, and other courses dealing with religious phenomena. Its goal is the development of highly trained academics – researchers and lecturers qualified to conduct internationally comparable research into current theoretical and practical issues in religious studies.

THEOLOGICAL STUDIES (DOUBLE HONOURS) - IN CONNECTION WITH THE FACULTY OF ARTS

3 years, 90 ECTS

The Theological Studies programme is an interdisciplinary approach to theology together with the fields of philosophy, sociology, psychology and ethics. The programme is based on the biblical and theological dimensions of life, understood in the light of the Christian tradition. Graduates gain basic knowledge of the religious and social situation in Europe, of the possibilities of ecumenical, interfaith dialogue and of theological issues in contemporary culture.
