### Religiology and Ethics

The study of Religiology and Ethics gives the greatest emphasis to the humanities or philosophical, ethical, spiritual, theological and religious concepts of life, interpersonal relationships and gives the masters of the Religiology and Ethics programme a broad basis in this field for further education and work. Students get acquainted with the methodology in the field of religious research, the relationship between religions, ethics, media, etc.

Masters of Religiology and Ethics with a completed university programme in Theology and Religious Studies are employable as pastoral assistants and professional pastoral workers. With additional training they are employable in the field of social services, educational institutions and public administration. A broad interdisciplinary education enables them to work in the political field, in the media and in publishing houses. Knowledgeable in religions and cultures, they are successful in public relations services and organize cultural and other events.
