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## Second cycle double honours study programme

#### **Education in Theology**

In this second cycle study programme, students upgrade their previous education with pedagogical and didactic skills. The programme focuses on a specific area of work and thinking. At the level of master's study, programme participants acquire specialized knowledge and skills that complement their basic knowledge in the field of belief and the system of religions, so that it can be used in educational practice.

Most of the content and emphasis in the programme corresponds to the field of philosophy, logic, pedagogy and ethics, as it deals mainly with educational, philosophical, ethical, spiritual and other concepts of life and interpersonal relationships. The field of education and orientation in the humanities is also suitable due to the inclusion of the programme in the Faculty of Theology (also in terms of content through common subjects with other programmes).

Theology gives students all the necessary methodological and pedagogical competences (pedagogical module), as well providing knowledge from specific theological disciplines related to contemporary theological and religious issues. The study programme complements the knowledge and competences that students acquire in the second field of the double-honours study, thus developing students' abilities for interdisciplinary professional work.

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## Single cycle master programme Theology

The study programme Theology is the basic programme of the Faculty of Theology, which we implement in the spirit of tradition and connection with the needs of the environment and employers (Slovenian Bishops' Conference and religious communities of Slovenia).

Theology is an interdisciplinary study that combines other humanities, such as history, anthropology, philosophy, cultural studies, archeology, biblical sciences, psychology, sociology, educational and rhetorical sciences, etc. It is a study with a long tradition that includes a broad classical education, in order to make it easier to understand humans in the light of theological findings both from primary sources and from the tradition of theological sciences.

Students become professionally and personally broad-minded through the study of Theology. The programme is primarily directed at seminarians and religious order candidates, but it is also open to lay people who wish to deepen their theological knowledge.

What do the students say about the programme?

Studying at the Faculty of Theology has brought me a deep understanding of interpersonal relationship. To have faith and live your faith means to have a relationship with God, and the relationship that we build with God is the basis for all other relationships we build with people.

#### **Theological studies**

The first cycle double-honours university study programme Theological Studies is an interdisciplinary approach that primarily extends to the field of theology and, indirectly, to the fields of philosophy, sociology, psychology and ethics.

Globally, however, the programme is based on the biblical and theological dimensions of life, whereby is understood in the light of the Christian tradition. In this paradigm, humans as a social or spiritual beings always transcend the captivity of the moment. In this perspective, the programme's philosophy places humans at the centre of the educational process in the given moment and situation.

Graduates of theological studies acquire basic knowledge of the religious, ecclesiastical and social situation in Europe; they become acquainted with the possibilities of ecumenical, interfaith dialogue and develop a sense of theological issues in contemporary culture.

The programme is suitable for students who wish to acquire basic knowledge in theological and religious studies while interested in other studies as well. The interdisciplinary nature of the studies allows students to integrate religious, spiritual, ethical and cultural knowledge into their personal and professional life.
